Employers reported a global Net Employment Outlook of 23% for the final quarter of 2025




The strongest **employment Outlooks** are reported by employers in the U.A.E.



Across sectors, the IT industry continues to report the strongest hiring intentions


Global Net Employment Outlook


Used internationally as a bellwether of labor market trends, the Net Employment Outlook – calculated by subtracting the percentage of employers who anticipate reductions to staffing levels from those who plan to hire – stands at 23%.




Hiring Expectations for October - December

Of the 42 countries, employers in 12 countries report a stronger hiring outlook compared to the same period last year, while 26 report a weakening outlook, and 3 remain unchanged.
